Creating Paper Textiles: Basic Eastern Techniques with Anzara Clark Wed 3rd July, 9-3pm

Learn the basics of traditional Korean and Japanese paper manipulation techniques, that are used to turn paper into cloth. Joomchi (paper felting) and Momigami (paper strengthening and texturing) processes will be taught, along with basic Kami- ito (paper thread making). These techniques and processes can be used in a range of creative applications.

Create a Personalised Trouser Pattern with Alice Cliff Sat 6th & Sun 7th July, 9-2pm

This workshop is for sewing enthusiasts who want to take it to the next level and step into the world of pattern making. Standard trouser pattern in size 8-22 are provided as a starting point to alter to your personal measurements and dimensions. We will create the pattern, cut out and sew up in calico to check the fit and make any final amends for the perfect fit.

Natural Dyeing Yarn with The Bunbury Spinners Wed 10th July, 10-2pm

Try out a range of natural dye methods and materials using local foraged materials and purchased dyes. You will get to sample with cotton, wool and silk yarns. From this you'll create a simple sample booklet.

Sew a Winter Coat with Lauren Jeffery Sat 13th & Sun 14th July, 10-3pm

Join Lauren over 2 days to sew yourself a cosy winter coat. These coats are lined for max comfort, they can be made from many different fabrics but are most popular for their use of upcycling old woolen blankets.. Breathe new life into something old or choose a new fabric you love.

Mega Crossbody Zip Bag with Rosa Sallis Sat 29th and Sun 30th June, 9-2pm

Participants will make a bag they can wear as an everyday accessory. This will include how to put in zippers, zipper tabs and boxing corners for bag bottoms.

Intro to Weaving with The Bunbury Weavers Sat 6th & Sat 13th July, 9am-12pm

Learn different tapestry weaving techniques using a variety of yarns and colours to create a small wall hanging.

Wired Up! Combining wool felt & wire with Martien van Zuilen Sat 29th June, 10-4pm

Join Martien for a day of felting on a precious scale! Combining the softness of wool fibres and the cool potential of wire, you will learn innovative techniques to make uniquely shaped sculptural shapes for 3D works.

Intro to "Dirty Pot" Eco Dyeing on fabric with Sandra Goerling Tue 2nd July, 9-2pm

This workshop is an introduction to using the colours provided by nature to dye fabric without using any manufactured chemicals. This process can be used to upcycle clothing or create textiles to use in other projects.
